Hutchinson, Kansas – Collins Industries, a leading manufacturer of specialty vehicles in the United States, announced today their intention to divest of the Waldon industrial loader line located in Fairview, Oklahoma. The product line is being sold to two key employees with the facilities and land housing the Waldon line being sold to the city of Fairview. The Waldon industrial loader line is currently part of Mobile Products Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Collins Industries, Inc.

“We have been working closely over the past few months with Fairview city and community leaders in an attempt to keep the Waldon industrial loader line operating in Fairview, Oklahoma. With the city’s help of this employee led buyout, we believe this sale will provide the Waldon industrial loader lines the greatest opportunity to succeed in the future.” stated Phillip Ford, President of Mobile Products, Inc.
